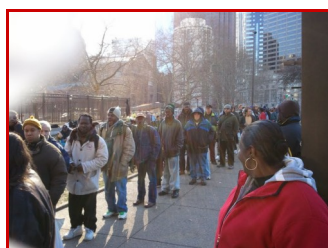
## Stroehmann Bakeries Walk+Run Against Hunger

### Meaningful MLK Day

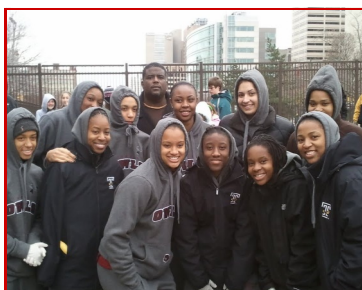
